 - using disparaging, obscene or insulting language;
 - personal attacks impugning character and/or integrity;
 - intimidation;
 - disorderly conduct as defined in Section 30-1-2 of this Revised Code of Ordinances;
 - (f) Any speaker who engages in such prohibited conduct during public participation shall be called to order by the chair or ruling by the chair if a point of order is made by a sitting Alderman.
