**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:**

Michael Hagberg stated he felt the no right turn on red on High at “A” should come to the meeting to be looked into. There is a turn lane and room for people to nose out without causing a major problem.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**E.1 No Right Turn on Red – N. High & East “A” St.** Alderman Pusa said she sees no problem at this intersection and the Police have stated there has been no accidents in three years. Alderman Elmore made a motion seconded by Alderman Pusa to remove from agenda. No action necessary.

**E.2 No Thru Trucks at Green Mount Manors:** Discussion ensued, for clarification, on where these no thru truck signs need to go, in addition to a no left turn behind Wal-mart. No Thru Trucks and a No Left Turn need to be posted on Green Mt. Commons Drive at the rear exit/entrance at Wal-mart. Another no thru truck sign to be posted on Commons Parkway at N. Green Mount. Tim Gregowicz will mark the areas and make sure signs are within the City’s right-of-way. Motions, made February 9th, will go to city council for approval to have an ordinance drawn.

Chairman White just wanted to say he had been asked about stop signs on long stretches of road to slow down speeders. He’s asking for some thought on solutions.

Gregowicz said the solar powered pedestrian crossings on West Boulevard are up at Belleville East.

Alderman Elmore explained the mission statement for Tour de Belleville is to buy safety equipment and possibly some movable solar powered speed signs would be something to look into.
