INSPECTORS REPORT

- In the month of June there were 155 total inspections. Of the 155 inspections, 85 were housing inspections and 70 were other inspections.
- No tickets were issued since last meeting.

OLD BUSINESS

- Interviewed Lou Schreier with AMF electric. Based on the documentation received the commission will sponsor his electrical license.
- James Hickman of Current Plus was given to August 15 to correct all violations discussed at previous commission meetings. If all corrections are not made, his license will be suspended at that time. During the commission meeting on August 22 permanent suspension of his license will be discussed if all violations are not brought up to code at that time. In addition a discussion will be conducted on the future of his license in the City of Belleville.

NEW BUSINESS

- The commission led a discussion on swimming pool contractors installing electrical conduit. This is considered to be a life safety installation, conduit and grounding must be installed and inspected by a qualified electrical contractor/inspector. Janet and Ken will put together a checklist and handout to give contractors when they apply for a permit.
- A discussion was led by the commission on the installation of recessed luminaries with 3" apertures. The discussion was tabled until next meeting until more information on the fixtures can be obtained.
- The commission led a discussion on (425 ILCS 60/) Smoke detector Act and public Act 094-0731, Carbon Monoxide Alarm Detector Act. It was decided that a home owner must follow these Acts if they are doing a major remodel on their

home. What constitutes a major rebuild will be at the discretion of the housing inspector.

The next meeting will be held on **August 22, 2016** at 6:00 p.m. in the Housing Department, 407 E. Lincoln St. Due to renovations at City Hall.


