The minutes of the last meeting in July were read and approved with changes.

INSPECTORS REPORT

- In the month of July there were 179 total inspections. Of the 179 inspections, 82 were housing inspections and 97 were other inspections.
- No tickets were issued since last meeting.

OLD BUSINESS

- The swimming pool inspection checklist was not completed prior to this meeting. It will be composed and reviewed at the September Commission meeting.
- A discussion was led by the commission on the installation of recessed luminaries with 3" apertures. These will be approved only if they are accessible for maintenance.
- The commission led a discussion on (425 ILCS 60/) Smoke detector Act and public Act 094-0731, Carbon Monoxide Alarm Detector Act. It was decided that a home owner must follow these Acts if they are doing a major remodel on their home. Remodel of 50% or more of the building constitutes a major remodel.

NEW BUSINESS

- Mike Rosciglione of M.E.R. Signs appeared before the commission due to his missed license renewal payment. He discussed if we could reinstate his current license. Larry explained to him the renewal process and what needs to accrue to renew his license on an annual basis. The commission approved renewal of his license per section 24-3-5 (K) of the Electrical Ordinance.

- A discussion was led by the commission on the adaptation of the 2008 from the 2005 NEC since the Prometric test no longer exists for the 2005 code. This issue was table for further research.
- James Hickman of Current Plus Electric appeared before the commission to discuss the future of his license within the City of Belleville. All of his existing permits were inspect and approved for the current electrical codes. Mike explained to him that all of his work must be kept up to current codes at all times. This type of work needs to be the norm for his company.

The next meeting will be held on **September 26, 2016** at 6:00 p.m. in the Housing Department, 407 E. Lincoln St. Due to renovations at City Hall.
