W. "A" at N. 1st St- Stop Request

Chairman White began by reading statistics from the police department regarding accidents at the intersection of W. "A" and N. 1st St. Since November 2013 there have been 6 accidents at this intersection. 3 were due to inability to yield and the other 3 were from turning left at stop sign. *Discussion ensued.* Alderman Pusa made a motion to table stop sign request pending trial of placing arrows to show drivers to go and also a "cross traffic does not stop" sign. Right lane would be thru only and the left lane will be left turn or thru. Alderman Elmore seconded the motion. All members present voted aye. Motion Carried.

Request for no parking- N. Church St from Lucinda going north

Alderman Ken Kinsella stated that there was not a petition put together, however this was brought up by a constituent who lives on the other side of Sherman. They are requesting only parking on one side of street. One block down on Lucinda is St. Theresa's School and Church. Discussion ensued over how to handle the parking. Alderman Pusa made a motion for No parking on school side of N. Church from Lucinda to Sherman. Alderman Elmore seconded the motion. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.
