

ATTENTION BELLEVILLE RESIDENTS

Construction of pump and electrical upgrades to the "B" Street Pump Station Improvement Project, located at 1200 E. "B" Street, Belleville, IL are financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and received a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This project includes, but is not limited to: replacing existing medium voltage power service with 480Volt service, replacing existing pump motors and all associated power apparatus in the station including motor control center, power distribution panels and circuit breakers, lights, receptacles, level sensors and associated equipment. This project also includes removal and replacement of the existing pumps and associated discharge tubes, check valves and piping. The improvements will include all related civil, site, mechanical, structural, and electrical work required for a complete and operational pump station. Once complete, it will improve water quality for area residents and businesses in East Belleville by alleviating street flooding and sewage backups in the vicinity of the pump station. In addition, this project will improve pump station reliability and provide efficient operations. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
