Construction of the 23rd Street Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Lift Station and West E Street Sewer Replacement Project (Phase 4 of the City of Belleville's Long Term Control Plan) is being financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This project includes the construction of the 23rd Street CSO Lift Station, CSO relief sewers, a CSO force main, and sanitary sewer replacement. Once complete, it will improve water quality for area residents and businesses in the City by reducing the number of combined sewer overflows. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
