

ORDINANCE NO. 7776

A ZONING ORDINANCE IN RE CASE #31APR14

THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS (THE "CITY"), IS A DULY ORGANIZED AND EXISTING MUNICIPALITY CREATED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS.

THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE IS NOW OPERATING UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL CODE, AS SUPPLEMENTED AND AMENDED AND AS A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY PURSUANT TO ARTICLE VII OF THE ILLINOIS CONSTITUTION OF 1970; AND IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, ILLINOIS:

Whereas, an application has been filed requesting a Special Use permit for a liquor license at 341 Centreville Ave. located in a C-2 Heavy Commercial Zoning District. (Applicable portion of zoning code: 60-6-50).

Whereas, a public hearing has been held before the City's Zoning Board of Appeals which has issued its advisory report.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Belleville, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the application requesting a Special Use permit for a liquor license at 341 Centreville Ave. located in a C-2 Heavy Commercial Zoning District is hereby granted with the following stipulation: (Applicable portion of zoning code: 60-6-50)

1. In the name of the applicant only.

Section 2. That conflicting ordinances or pertinent portions thereof in force at the time of this ordinance takes effect are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, all as provided by law.
