 - Personal attacks impugning character and/or integrity;
 - Intimidation;
 - Disorderly conduct as defined in Section 130.02 of this revised code of ordinances.

1. Mascoutah Ave.

Motion to approve Christ Bros. Asphalt lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$699,889.49 for improvements to Mascoutah Ave. Work consists of HMA surface removal and replacement, sidewalk removal, construction of new sidewalk ramps, curb removal, new concrete curb, detectable warnings, pavement markings, signs, and all other work necessary to complete the project.
