 - (d) Repetitive public comments should be avoided, to the extent practical, through adoption of prior public comment (e.g. agreeing with prior speaker);
 - (e) The following conduct is prohibited during public participation:
 - Acting or appearing in a lewd or disgraceful manner;
 - Using disparaging, obscene or insulting language;
 - Personal attacks impugning character and/or integrity;
 - Intimidation;
 - Disorderly conduct as defined in Section 130.02 of this revised code of ordinances.

8. New Business

1. 6th Street Improvements

Motion to approve Baxmeyer Construction, Inc., lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$1,597,777.77 for improvements to 6th Street. Work consists of new roadway, driveways and sidewalks for sections of S. 6th, Centreville Ave, West Lincoln and West Washington. New layout for the intersection of S. 6th, Centreville Ave. and West Lincoln. (TIF 3 Funds)

2. Allsup Place

Motion to approve Kinney Construction, lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$532,898.82 for improvements to Allsup PI. Work consists of pavement patching, pipe underdrains and HMA resurfacing. (RBI Funds)
