OLD BUSINESS:

E1. Discussion of Handicap Parking Downtown-S. Jackson & E. Main St.:

There is now one (1) handicap parking space at N. Church & E. Main Street in the process of getting completed per Jason Poole. The area currently being discussed is located at S. Jackson & E. Main St., which is between Circa and the Copper Fire Restaurant. Jason Poole doesn't feel that there is any space for a handicap spot here due to the sidewalks and utility poles. Mr. Poole feels that if the committee is going to pursue another handicap spot, it needs to be at the northeast corner of N. Jackson & E. Main St. Discussion ensued. Ald. Elmore suggested that this item be tabled and removed from the agenda until further notice from Jason Poole.

E.2. Further Discussion of Residential Speeding Controls:

Jason Poole, Ald. Elmore, Lt. Harris, and others have previously met and talked about this issue. The best idea is to use police officers to patrol the areas. Discussion ensued. Ald. Elmore requested that this item be removed from the agenda.

E.3. Request to Place Private Dumpster on Public Parking Lot at the Rear of 310 East Main St.:

Ald. Elmore stated that this is a City parking lot and is commonly used for parking at the Old Town Mall. The dumpster that is currently here on sight is located on Mr. Gilpin's property and not on the public parking lot, in which both parties were previously sharing. Mr. Faltus is actively searching for an area in this vicinity to set a new dumpster in place and is asking the City for assistance. Discussion ensued. Ald. Elmore requested that more research is needed and to table this item until next month's meeting.




