F1. Possible Motion to Remove the No Parking from the West Side of S. Delaware from E. Main to the Dead End: The previous mayor's administration received some complaints on this matter, so the city engineer met with Mayor Eckert and the city clerk to evaluate on S. Delaware. The complaint is the residents have nowhere to park when they have any guests at their homes. If their driveways are full, they have nowhere to park on S. Delaware. Then, people look to park on E. Main St., which there is no place to park either. There was an inquiry about the City possibly purchasing a piece of property on S. Delaware and making it a private parking lot, but concluded that this was excessive at this point. Also, a complaint was received (in Ward 7) about a resident parking a large trailer at the end of the street. This has made it very difficult for any trash trucks, emergency vehicles, or others to navigate through the street. Discussion ensued. Motion to remove the no parking from the west side

of S. Delaware from E. Main to the dead end made by Ald. Dintelman, seconded by Ald. Ferguson, roll call vote occurred, motion carried.

MISCELLANEOUS/ALDERMANIC DISCUSSION:

Ald. Elmore asked that the topic "Discussion for Possible Parking Issues at 1st Block of E. Main St." be added onto next month's traffic agenda. This area is in front of the new coffee and donut shop. New striping does not allow parking on the street and this would be an additional parking spot for customers to use.


ADJOURNMENT:
