

ORDINANCE NO. 8422-2020

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI (BUSINESS REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 111 (AMUSEMENT AND RECREATION; RAFFLES), BY REPEALING SECTION 111.002 (FIREWORKS) OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF BELLEVILLE, ILLINOIS, AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING PORTIONS OF SECTIONS THEREOF**

THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS (THE "CITY"), IS A DULY ORGANIZED AND EXISTING MUNICIPALITY CREATED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS.

THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE IS NOW OPERATING UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL CODE, AS SUPPLEMENTED AND AMENDED AND AS A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY PURSUANT TO ARTICLE VII OF THE ILLINOIS CONSTITUTION OF 1970; AND IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, ILLINOIS:

**Section 1.** That **Section 111.002 (Fireworks)** is hereby repealed in entirety.

**Section 2.** That conflicting Ordinances or pertinent portions thereof in force the time this takes effect are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.
