

ORDINANCE NO. 8863-2020

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 74 (PARKING REGULATIONS) OF THE
REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, ILLINOIS
AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING PORTIONS OF SECTIONS THEREOF**

THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS (THE "CITY"), IS A DULY ORGANIZED AND EXISTING MUNICIPALITY CREATED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS.

THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE IS NOW OPERATING UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL CODE, AS SUPPLEMENTED AND AMENDED AND AS A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY PURSUANT TO ARTICLE VII OF THE ILLINOIS CONSTITUTION OF 1970; AND IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That **Chapter 74** is hereby amended by adding the following subsections under 74.02 NO PARKING RULES:

(N) At any City of Belleville owned premises, in Residential Districts including Multi-Family Districts, unless permitted by ordinance; and

(O) Within 25 feet in either direction of the Police Department's Speed Monitor Trailer.

Section 2. That conflicting Ordinances or pertinent portions thereof in force the time this takes effect are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, in pamphlet, all as provided by law.
