*Dog Park*

1. Users of this facility do so at their own risk. The City of Belleville is not responsible for any injury or damage caused by any dog in the off-leash area.
2. The Dog Park is restricted to paid members only. To obtain a membership, proof of rabies vaccinations will be required from a licensed veterinarian when applying. Vaccinations must be kept current.
3. Do not bring your dog(s) if they are injured, sick or in poor health.
4. Member's identification must only be used for his/her entry. A \$10 fee will be charged for lost key cards.
5. Do not allow non-members entry into the park.
6. Please keep your dog(s) from jumping on other dogs and people.
7. Close the gates except when entering or exiting the off-leash or catch pin areas.
8. Pick up waste and dispose of it in the receptacles provided.
9. Owner/handlers are responsible for the actions of their dog(s). This includes any injury, damages to property or to injury to other dogs, or to the public.
10. Children under 16 years should be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older. Children 5 and under are not permitted in the off-leash area.
11. A handler, aged 16 or older, must always be present and is solely responsible for the actions of their dog(s).
12. Dog(s) must be leashed prior to entering and leaving the park. Handlers must always carry a leash.
13. Collars must always be worn. No pinched or spiked collars are permitted in the off-leash area, as they are dangerous when playing.
14. Prevent your dog(s) from digging and handlers must refill holes created by their dog(s).
15. Keep your dog(s) in sight and never leave your dog(s) in the park unattended.
16. Handlers must discourage their dog(s) from running to "meet" other dogs at the gate entrance.
17. Do not allow your dog to bully any other dog(s).
18. No aggressive dog(s) allowed. Dogs with a known history of, or who exhibit aggressive or dangerous behavior are prohibited. Immediately leash your dog and leave the park if aggressive behavior is observed.
19. A limit of three (3) dogs per person is allowed at one time. The dog(s) must remain in the same run-area with their handler.
20. Large dogs, over 25 lbs., are not allowed in the small dog area if a small dog is entering or currently using the small dog area. If the owner of a small dog is approaching the park, you must immediately remove your large dog to the large dog side.
21. A small dog may play in the large dog area at their own risk, but it is not recommended.
22. Dogs in heat are not permitted in the park.
23. Puppies must be at least 4 months old to use the park.
24. No glass, food of any kind (including dog treats), bikes, motorized devices (other than for handicap mobility) are allowed within the fenced area.
25. Hours of usage are from sunrise to sunset.
26. Refrain from smoking in the Dog Park.
27. Cooperation between owners is expected and required.
28. All dog owner/handler(s) who fail to comply with the above rules may be asked to leave the Dog Park and may have their park membership suspended or revoked without annual fees refunded.
29. The Belleville Parks and Recreation department will not mediate civil differences between owner/handlers. ***We reserve the right to refuse, suspend and revoke any membership at any time.***
